

VEGETARIAN RECIPE

Potato Bake with Tomatoes & Oregano

1/3 cup extra virgin olive oil1-1/2 lb. potatoes, peeled & thinly sliced1/2 tsp. dried oreganoSalt & freshly ground black pepper to taste

1 large onion, chopped 12 oz. cherry tomatoes, halved 1/2 cup fine dry bread crumbs



- 1. Preheat oven to 400 degrees. Oil a large ovenproof dish
- 2. Heat 2 TBS. oil in a large frying pan over medium heat. Add the onion and saute until softened ... 4 5 minutes. Add the potatoes and saute for 5 minutes. Season with salt and pepper.
- 3. Transfer to the ovenproof dish. Arrange the tomatoes in a layer on top of layered potatoes. Sprinkle with oregano and bread crumbs. Drizzle with remaining oil.
- 4. Bake uncovered until potatoes are tender ... 35-40 minutes. Serve hot.
- 5. Serves 4-6 Enjoy! CRC


