Progressive Dinner - April 12 at 5 pm





Vegetarian Recipe

VEGETABLE GRATIN

6 zucchini, thinly sliced
6 tomatoes, finely chopped
6 cloves garlic, lightly crushed but whole
1 cup finely chopped fresh basil
Salt & freshly ground black pepper
½ cup extra-virgin olive oil
1 egg

1 cup heavy (double) cream

- 1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Grease a 12 inch baking dish.
- 2. Arrange half the zucchini in a layer in the prepared dish. Top with half the tomatoes. Sprinkle with half the garlic and basil. Season with salt and pepper and drizzle with the olive oil.
- 3. Top with the remaining zucchini and cover with the remaining tomatoes. Sprinkle with the remaining garlic and basil.
- 4. Beat the egg and cream and season with salt and pepper. Pour over the vegetables.
- 5. Bake until the vegetables are tender ... 50 60 minutes. Serve hot. Servings: 4-6.

Serve as a side dish or as a main dish with a green salad and crusty bread.




MEMORIALS

FUMC on Social Media – share your church with family & friends!



Are you on Facebook, Twitter or other social media sites? Let your friends and 'followers' know you attend First UMC! Before or after church, post a message saying you were at First UMC. If you have a smartphone, use the "check-in" feature. You can also "like" our Facebook page (*First United Methodist Church*) and "join" the Facebook group (*First United Methodist Church of Buckhannon, WV*).

We are also using the hashtag #firstchurchum and many folks have asked "What is a hashtag?" Hashtags are short links or phrases preceded by the pound or number sign (#) used on social media sites such as Twitter and Facebook. The pound sign (or hash) turns any word or group of words that directly follow it into a searchable link. This allows for organized content that is grouped together so that you can track discussion topics based on those keywords. Use a hashtag to join the conversation. Click on a hashtag to see all the posts that mention that particular subject. A hashtag can be used in the middle of a sentence or post, or it can be used at the end. Spaces are not used with hashtags, even if your hashtag contains multiple words, group them all together. If you want to differentiate between words, use capitals instead. Numbers can be used, but punctuation and special characters cannot.
