We knew the Second Phase of the Audio/Visual Project needed to move forward to completion, but we had no idea the missional need was so great. FUMC needs your help so that completion of the 2nd Phase can become a reality. Due to the need of Online Worship now, and our continuing to reach out with Online Worship in the future, we have pulled together our best resources, along with the Online Worship Team, to do the job of Sunday Morning Online Worship. The 2nd Phase will also enhance the In-Person Worship experience by increasing visibility during worship on the monitors, the use of video for special presentations, Wiggletime and baptism close-ups, project service hymns and responses, etc. Some pieces of necessary equipment had to be purchased to get us where we are now, but First Church does not have the needed cameras, controls, electronics, hardware, and computer to do the job appropriately and carry this new component and venue of worship into the future. The cost for everything is estimated at \$18,000. Some pieces of the equipment have already been purchased which lowers the estimate approximately \$1,500, and we have received already some monetary gifts. THANK YOU! SOFT DATE SET TENTATIVELY TO RETURN TO IN-PERSON WORSHIP JUNE 14

Following the direction of our Bishop and the Cabinet, no church in the West Virginia Annual Conference should be planning worship through the month of May. First UMC has put together a team of persons to evaluate the Covid-19 restrictions near the end of May. Those serving in the team are: Pastor, Steve Meadows; Dr. Dan Martin; Renee Warner; Karen Cartwright (Lay Leader); Barbara Loftis (President-UMW), Shea Phillips and Tom Bacorn (Maintenance-Custodian). Tentatively, we hope to be back for In-person worship sometime in June. Our target date is June 14, 2020. And, when we return, there will be social distancing guidelines that we will follow. Until then, please continue to join First UMC for worship online. And, Thank You for your patience and for your continued financial support during this time of "Safer at Home." We will be notifying the church family with instructions and if any developments or changes occur.

These guidelines are intended to help churches prepare for a "Re-Launch" of safe in person gatherings in phases.

SUGGESTED PHASES TO CONSIDER:

• Phase One: Worship

Phase Two: Meetings, small groups, Adult Sunday School, etc.

• Phase Three: Children and Youth Sunday School, activities, nursery

FACTORS TO BE ADDRESSED IN ALL PHASES:

- The maximum number of people who can gather in person while maintaining CDC social distancing procedures.
- Ability to maintain CDC sanitizing surfaces guidelines.
- Plans for communicating your intentions to your congregation, potential attenders from online viewers and community.

PHASE ONE: WORSHIP

To reduce contact with people, consider:

- Shorter Worship times, sanitizing in between groups.
- Use of a fellowship area, where social distance/sanitizing easier to do.
- No greeters, handshaking, hugging, Passing the Peace.
- No nursery. Families stay together.
- No nursery, children or youth ministry "in-person" until public schools are in session.
- No gathering of children up front for children's time.
- No refreshments gatherings for coffee, cookies, etc.
- No Holy Communion until safe guidelines are established
- Consider not doing baptisms at this time. If not, follow current CDC guidelines for social distance. Infant should stay in parents' arms. No walking infant up and down isle. Multiple baptisms would require separate water bowls, sanitizing hands in between.

To reduce contact with surfaces, consider:

- No bulletins or handouts of any kind.
- No passing offering plates, use separate collection site.
- No hymnals in pews.

To reduce air-borne contact with virus, consider:

- No congregational or choir singing, use recorded and/or instrumental.
- Limit responsive readings to between people, six feet apart.

PHASE TWO: Meetings, small groups, Adult Sunday School, etc.

- Follow all CDC guidelines current for social distancing and sanitizing.
- Consider how to communicate your plans to congregation and potential online and community people.

PHASE THREE: Children, Youth Sunday School, Nursery

- Follow all CDC guidelines current for social distancing and sanitizing.
- Consider how to communicate your plans to congregation and potential online and community people.

REMINDER: WV Conference website has many resources for Re-Launch and online worship. Click on Covid-19, then the appropriate link underneath. Check and check often conference website, state and federal guidelines.

JUST AS IMPORTANT DISCOVERY: Many have discovered a whole new community of people seeking the wisdom of the church through their online worship opportunities. God has opened up a whole new harvest field! We cannot forget them once we get back inside our church buildings. Online and potential community seekers must REMAIN in EVERY aspect of planning,

The Upshur Parish House is open every weekday morning for food pantry, utility assistance, etc., with strict guidelines to ensure safe social distancing for the Neighbors as well as those who are making donations. If you would care to donate items, call the Parish House (304-472-0743) anytime between 9 am and Noon, Monday through Friday to arrange a drop off of donations. The needs include: canned vegetables (anything except green beans and corn) - peas, carrots, mixed, etc. There are also many requests for personal hygiene items - toothbrushes, toothpaste, shampoo, deodorant, bar soap, tampons/pads, etc., and diapers (larger sizes 4, 5, and 6 or pull-ups). Also, the Parish House would like to provide face masks for all volunteers and staff, as well as neighbors when the Clothes Closet Thrift Store, Parish House, and Crosslines re-opens.
