# MAUNDY/HOLY THURSDAY

First Church will pause to remember the evening Jesus spent with the disciples in the Upper Room on the evening before the Crucifixion. Our observance will not be in person but via YouTube. The Link will be available early on Maundy Thursday so that you may pause at your convenience on that day to prepare for Good Friday.



Available via YouTube, Dr. Val Huffman has taken previous Choral anthems from previous Tenebrae worship services and combined the music with scripture to provide a challenging, reflective, and moving experience to help the viewer remember the events of the Day of Crucifixion. The YouTube will be available early on Good Friday so that viewers can pause at the Cross to prepare for the celebration of Easter.



If you feel that you must return to IN-PERSON WORSHIP, First Church will offer Sunday Worship, 10:45 am, beginning Sunday March 28, 2120. Pre-service music will begin at 10:40 AM followed with Worship beginning at 10:45 AM

- Doors will open at 10:20 am.
- UPON ARRIVAL YOU MUST REGISTER YOUR ATTENDANCE in Linger Hall in the event that contact tracing needs
  to be done. Registration must be done before entering the sanctuary for worship.
  Registration will be weekly.

### Please note that only certain doors to the church will be open to enter. These include:

- Black double doors on S. Florida St.
- First Floor glass doors (52 S. Florida St.) of the Christian Education Building
- Elevator (handicap) Door
- Back door closest to parsonage with stairway up to Linger Hall.

The doors on Latham St. (off the portico with the 3 archways) will remain locked.

### The following guidelines are for everyone's protection:

- If you are of a vulnerable age, have any underlying health issues, have allergy issues, are immunologically compromised in any way, any other health related concerns, or feel sick in any way, ... **PLEASE stay home and worship online.**
- All persons MUST bring and wear a mask, including children. You are encouraged to bring your own hand sanitizer. We have "some" masks and "some" hand sanitizer. If for health or other reasons you cannot wear a mask, then please, continue to worship On-line or by "Sermon-by-Phone."
- Unavailable seating will be marked on pews that respects Social Distancing. Families will sit together. Please, no hugging, handshaking, or personal contact that breaks the 6 feet requirement for Social Distancing.
- There will be no childcare, but the Nursery Worker will be on hand should there be a need for help.
- Please use the restroom before you leave home. The Unisex Restroom and the Women's Restrooms in the
  back of Linger hall will be open if needed. All other restrooms in the building will be closed. If you have any
  problems related to restroom usage, please stay home, and watch online.
- There will be no group singing, group recitations, bulletins, bibles or hymnals in pew racks.
- There is expected to be special music. At this time, there will be no Choir. The Covid-19 Quartet will still be providing singing during the hymns from an appropriately safe distance.
- There will be Wiggletime, but children must remain with their families and will not be allowed to gather at the Chancel.
- Offering plates will not be passed during worship but will be placed in Linger Hall before and after worship. Or, you may mail your offering to the church, or donate electronically.
- Please do not gather in the building before/after service; instead, wave, place your hand over your heart, or "air-hug" to greet folks. We can still find community as we worship.

### Following the Service:

• Those worshiping will be dismissed row by row during the Postlude, beginning with the balconies, then back rows, and on toward the front of the sanctuary. When leaving please continue to maintain 6 feet social distance.

### Ongoing notes regarding the church building:

- The Education building and other levels of the facility are closed until Adult Sunday School Resumes
- No Sunday school or other group gatherings will convene in the facility at this time.
- Children's Sunday school will remain available by YouTube. Children's Bulletins will be mailed each week. You will be notified of any other On-line opportunities.

This is **Phase One** in making FUMC worship space available again. This schedule will continue until further notice is given. First UMC appreciates your support and prayers during this time. As always, watch for social media and email for updates or changes.
