First Church will celebrate the sacrament of communion on World Communion Sunday, Oct. 3 at In-person worship. Those wishing to receive communion will safely pick up a pre-packaged grape juice/wafer in a zip-lock bag in Linger Hall as they arrive for worship. Following communion, persons

will be asked to put the empty container back in the zip-lock bag, seal the bag, and drop the used container/zip-lock bag in a trash container as they leave. It will be a Sacramental Celebration for the First Church family as we resume this holy gift.

The Board of Trustees is currently working toward

repointing, sealing, and repairing loose brickwork and capstones, and repairing loose flashing on the S. Florida side of the Old Main building (sanctuary). This will



prohibit moisture from seeping through the wall and creating interior wall issues of paint bubbling and plaster becoming soft and falling. As with most repair work,

correcting one problem uncovers another. The Trustees are committed to caring for our 120 old facility. And the Trustees are grateful for the patience of the Church family as they care for



the needs of First Church facility.

Also, the First Church family is grateful for a memorial gift given toward replacing the wooden fencing that begins at the District Office and stands along the perimeter of the



back yard and ends at the rear of the parsonage. The fencing work was completed on Sept. 29. The Trustees are grateful for the memorial gift and the seed funds to move

toward replacing the fence, a much-needed upgrade, and an attractive renovation for curb-appeal.


