Tenebrae/Good Friday Service of Shadows

MARCH 29, 7:00 PM IN THE SANCTUARY

The Service of Tenebrae follows a tradition of the church dating back to the 8th century. The service with the Chancel Choir and Congregational responses commemorates the final hours of the Lord's life on earth, as he suffered death upon the cross.

As candles are extinguished, they symbolize the fading loyalty of the disciples and friends of Jesus.

The gradual darkening of the church portrays the diminishing light of the world as Christ was departing from it.

This is not a time of applause and celebration, but rather a time of mourning and solemnity.

Following the conclusion of the evening people are invited, if they wish, to remain in silent reflection and meditation. The service ends as people leave in respectful silence and keep silence until they leave the building.

During the first week of February, 11 ladies from our unit made about 65 Valentine's Day cards. Most were made at the church during our unit meeting. UWF teamed up with the We Care Team of First United Methodist to send valentines to church members who have moved away, are home bound, or just need to know others remember them. Naomi Lynch graciously supplied most of the materials.

On **Thursday, March 7**, at 2 pm, Dave Poling and Phil Loftis will share information on the local **Habitat for Humanity**. Several church members are part of that ministry, which is supported by the church and United Women in Faith. **Everyone, males and females, are welcome to attend this presentation**.

Our bylaws were reviewed by the executive committee in February. A couple changes are needed since they state a person should not hold the same office for more than 4 consecutive years, and they have our previous name, United Methodist Women. The revised bylaws will be voted on at the March meeting.

United Women in Faith disbursed about \$9,000 during 2023. This was made possible with the support of the congregation, monetary pledges and volunteer hours from members and non-members, and leadership from our dedicated officers. We supported the pastor's discretionary fund, FUMC youth, and local service agencies. \$2,000 was sent to UMCOR for Maui relief, and \$1,000 donated to WVWC for the Rousch/Nickell Scholarship Fund. We hope we were able to make a positive impact in the lives of others.

WVU MEDICINE ST. JOSEPH'S HOSPITAL AND THE ROTARY CLUB OF BUCKHANNON-UPSHUR ANNOUNCE SPRING BLOOD SCREENING DATES

BUCKHANNON, WV- St. Joseph's Hospital and the Rotary Club of Buckhannon-Upshur will hold blood screenings on Saturdays in the spring. The dates are April 13, April 27, May 4 and May 11th. They will be held at St. Joseph's Hospital beginning at 7 am. Basic blood profile tests will be offered at \$35, with additional testing for thyroid for \$5, hemoglobin A1C for \$15, colon cancer screening for \$5 and prostate testing for \$20. An additional test for the Hepatitis C antibody will be offered for \$20. Appointments are required. To register for an appointment, go online to <u>https://RotaryBloodScreening.as.me/</u>. If you do not have internet access or need assistance, the Upshur County Library located at 1150 Route 20 South in Buckhannon or the Mountain CAP Family Support Center at 30 East Main Street next to CJ Maggie's Restaurant in Buckhannon can assist you in registering.
