My friends, families sit around a table to share news from the day, concerns about life, and stories they have heard. I invite you now to come to this table with the great family of creation to share the day, to listen to and experience God's story. It's a special table because it is big enough for all. It's a special table because it is made from the stuff of the earth: wood and ore, grain and fruit, all gifts from God.

Most of all, it's a special table because Jesus is here. Let us share God's story.

**Bless the One who comes to us in God's name.  
Heaven and earth are full of your glory.**

Jesus took bread and wine, the simplest of food, blessed it and held it, broke it, and shared it with people like us. Come, eat, and drink and belong to God's new community.
